The Hazeldell Board of Directors is seeking applicants to fill a vacancy on the Board of Directors!

A Fire District board member primarily acts in overseeing the budget of the fire district, ensuring the community receives fire protection services, while also planning strategic decisions about future development and needs within the community's limitations. The Board of Directors consists of five citizens living in the Hazeldell Rural Fire District. Board meetings are scheduled on the 4th Thursday of every month. The meetings are open to the public and input from the public is received at the meetings.

Requirements:

- Must be a registered voter in the Hazeldell Fire District and;
- Have had your primary residence within the Hazeldell Fire District for one year or more (confirmed by the Lane County Election's Office).

Key responsibilities of a Fire District board member include:

Budget oversight: Approving the annual budget, monitoring expenditures, and ensuring responsible use of taxpayer funds.

Strategic planning: Identifying future needs of the community and developing long-term plans to address them, including potential facility expansions or service upgrades.

Community engagement: Participating in public meetings, listening to resident concerns, and communicating the fire district's plans and actions to the community.

Legislative advocacy: Staying informed about relevant legislation and advocating for policies that benefit the fire district and community.

Important points to remember:

 Educational: Preferably willing to attend Elected Officials training, Oregon Dept. of Revenue annual budget training classes, and Conferences hosted by Special District Association of Oregon.

- **Not operational management:** While board members set policy, they do not directly manage day-to-day operations, which is the responsibility of the Fire Chief.
- **Elected Positions:** Fire District board members are elected by the community they serve.
- **Collaboration with the Fire Chief:** Effective board members maintain open communication with the Fire Chief to ensure alignment between strategic goals and operational execution.
